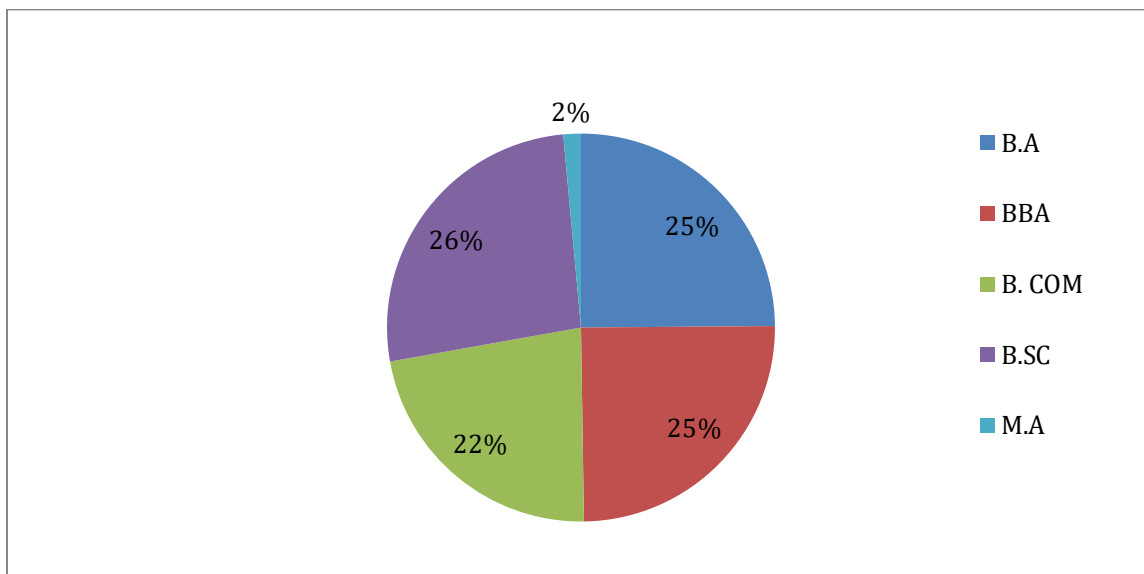

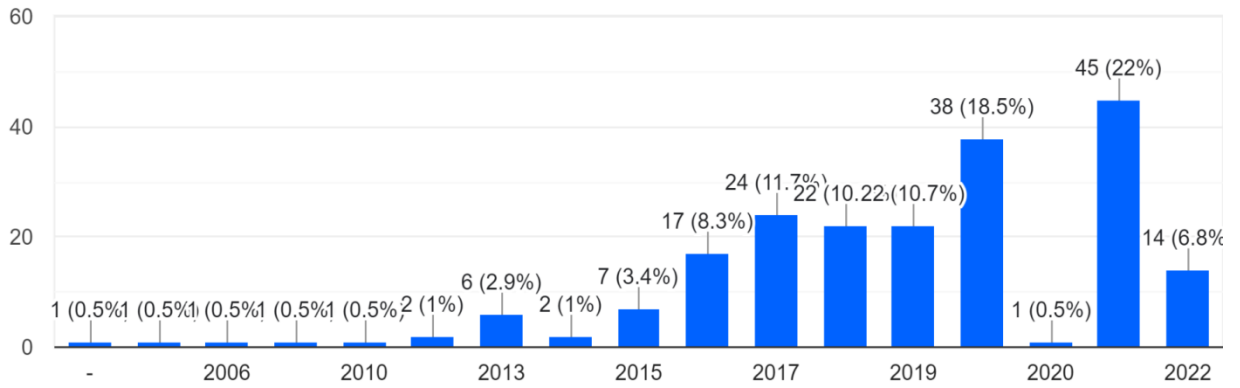

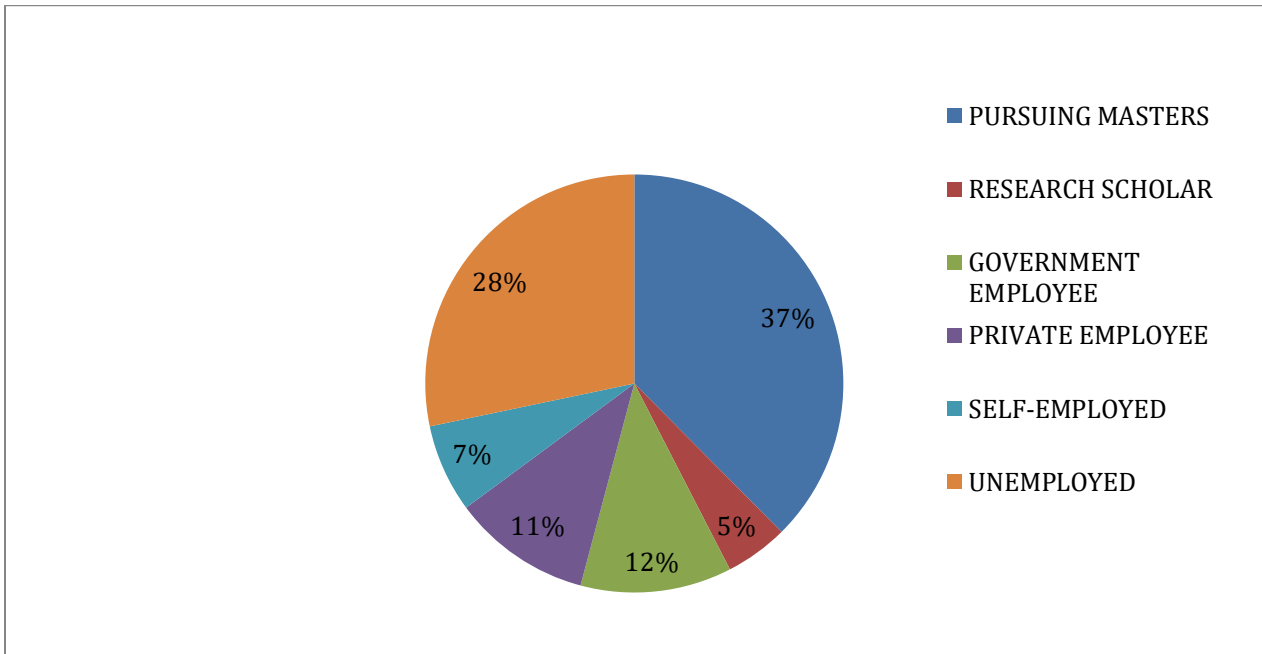


### Year of Graduation

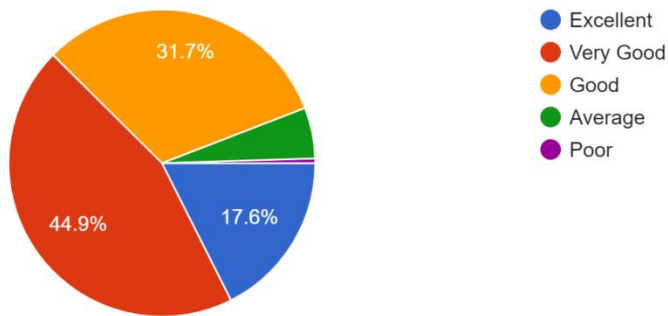

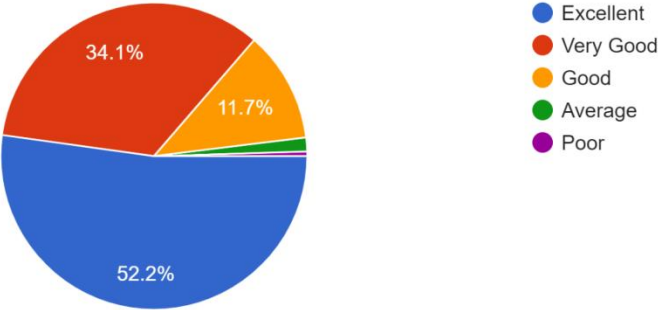

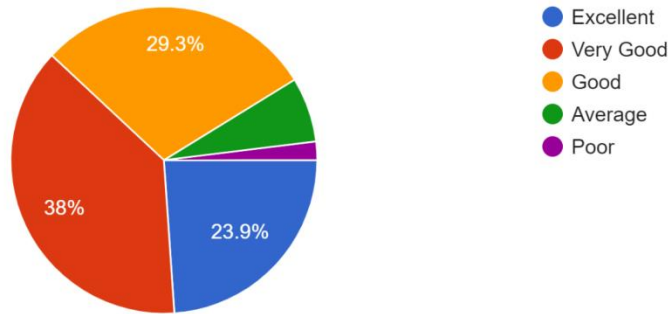
27. How do you rate the learning experience in terms of their relevance to the real life application?

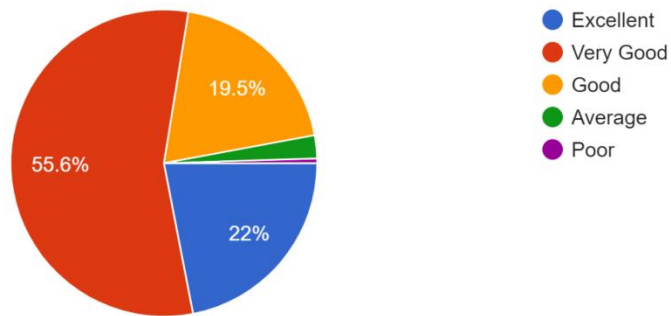
28. How do you rate the courses that you have learnt in relation to your current job?

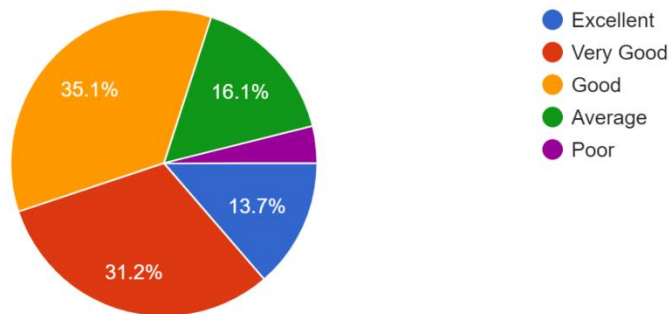
29. What is the caliber of students passing out of this college?

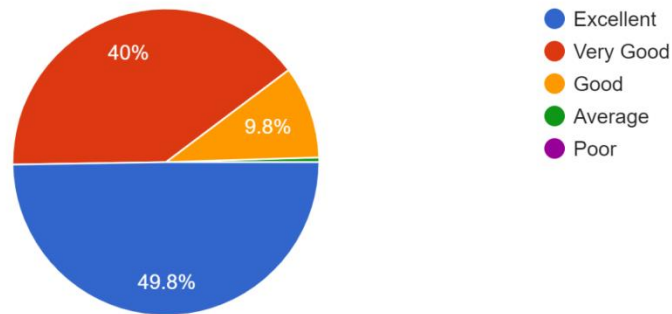
