## **CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:**

- To organise a National Webinar by IQAC SJC(A): The IQAC SJC (A) in collaboration with Kristu Jayanti College (A), Bengaluru and Nagaland College Principals Association on 6th and 7th July 2021
- 2. Offline/online classes for UG 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Semesters were re-opened on 7th July 2021
- 3. Orientation Program for UG and PG 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Students was conducted on 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 for B.Sc 1<sup>st</sup> Semester students, online orientation for BA 1<sup>st</sup> semester students on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2021, orientation programme for 1<sup>st</sup> semester BBA and B.Com students on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2021 and for PG 1<sup>st</sup> semester on 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2021, Offline orientation for BA 1<sup>st</sup> semester students on 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 and orientation for CRs and VCRs was held on 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2021.
