- 1. To promote research culture among the teaching faculties and the students.
- 2. To establish link with other institutions and organizations for research.
- 3. To create contacts with the real world and promote research through various publications
- 4. To monitor various research activities in the college

FUNCTIONS OF THE CELL

- 1. The Research and Development Cell will organize seminars, workshops, conferences, symposiums etc to develop research culture among the faculties and Students.
- 2. Identify the thrust areas of research in each department and advise the faculty to carry out research in collaboration with other organization.
- 3. In order to establish link with other institutions and organizations, the cell shall initiate faculty/students exchange program with various institutions and organizations.

4. The Research Cell will maintain a record of the research conducted by the students and the faculty members of the college for future reference by the academicians/ scholars.

5. The Research Cell will initiate proposal to visit different educational institutions with a view to study on the working plans of the institution and find out its applicability for the college.

The visitation will also be a part of the capacity building exercise for the research cell members,

6.The cell will encourage publishing of articles in books and journals, newspapers articles, and paper presentations. For this, the cell has initiated to introduce a Journal of the college.

- 7. Review and monitor academic progress of teaching faculties/ Students registered for PH.Ds.
- 8. Promote and encourage inter-disciplinary research.

9. Scrutinize minor and major research project proposals for submission to funding organizations such as UGC, AICTE, DST, DRDO, ICSSR etc.

10. Identify the budgetary requirements and resources for funding the research, review the progress of research and offer necessary guidance whenever required.

ACTIVITIES (2018-22)

- Signed an MOU between North Eastern Social Research Centre (NESRC, Guwahati) and St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Jakhama.
- Initiated a collaborative major project entitled "The Impact of Socio-Economic Changes on the Culture of the Youths of Nagaland" with the NESRC, Guwahati.
- Dr. Sumi Daa-Dharo represented the college and presented a paper on "The Role of Women in Peace Processes" organised by the North Eastern Social Research Centre (NESRC, Guwahati) from 2nd-3rd Nov, 2010. 2018.

A proposal was sent to the college for setting up a research cell office in the PG Block building.

□ A proposal was made to visit some premiere educational institutions and universities to establish link with other universities and exchange ideas on future collaborations.

Later on the 3rd Nov, 2022, the cell proposed to introduce Journal for Social Sciences. Dr. Dominic Meyieho was chosen as the Chief Editor of the Journal.

- Name of the Journal: "St. Joseph's Journal for Social Sciences: Inter-view and Dialogue"
- On 8th of November the application for journal title verification was uploaded on the website. After proper verification the hard copy was verified by SDO (Civil) Jakhama, Kohima, Nagaland. On 11th of November the hard copy was dispatched to RNI (Newspaper in India) for ISSN registration.

REPORT OF RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT CELL (2018-2022)

□ <u>2018</u>

- A meeting of the Research and Development Cell was held on 3rd August, 2018. Though the cell was at its initial stage, the Cell proposed to take up a Major Project in collaboration with the North Eastern Social Research Centre (NESRC), Guwahati.
- Another meeting of the Research Cell was held on 9th August, 2018 to discuss about the update on the proposed project with the Project Consultant, Dr. Walter Fernandes, Director, North Eastern Social Research Centre, Guwahati

- The house decided to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for undertaking long term research collaboration between St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Jakhama and North Eastern Social Research Centre, Guwahati.
- The Research Project data and Reports will be owned by St. Joseph's College.
- Another meeting of the Research Cell was convened on 23rd August, 2018 to deliberate upon the upcoming Research Project.
- Some of the important points deliberated are: To establish link with other institutions and organizations for Student Exchange Programmes, to introduce Choice Based Credit Course, design syllabus of the courses based on Practicability, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Skill development to enable the students to be employable in future, among others.

After the meeting with the Principal, the Cell members held another meeting to discuss the following various issues concerning the Research Cell of the college:-

- To set up a Research Cell office in the Post-Graduate building for the proper functioning of the Cell.
- □ It was also apprehended that a list of things and facilities are required for the maintenance and functioning of the Cell.
- The Research Cell will maintain a record of the research/s.
- To put up a proposal for utilising the fund from the college for the Research Cell to visit different educational institutions with an aim to study on the working plans of other institutions and further analyze its applicability for the college. The visitation will also be a part of the capacity building exercise for the Research Cell members.

Another meeting of the Research Cell was held on 6th September, 2018. The important agendas discussed in the meeting are:-

- The members discussed the working progress of the College Journal.
- In view of the retraction of Sponsorship of Major Project/s by the UGC, the members decided to reschedule the application for the proposed to March, 2019
- However, the members will continue to work on improvising the project proposal

- The Research and Development Cell held a meeting on 20th June, 2019. The following details were discussed in the meeting:-
- The members deliberated on the Research Project Proposal for consideration.
- To request the college to sponsor the Research Project in-case of delay by the other funding agencies.


□ <u>2022</u>

- The Principal also highlighted about the research project proposals of Dr. Mhonthung Yanthan and Dr. Khriemenuo Pusa.
- The Principal also deliberated about the functions of the committee to be made known later.

- A meeting of the Journal and Publication Committee related to research cell was held on 3rd November, 2022.
- The following were the agendas deliberated by the members:
- 1. The house decided that St. Joseph's College (A), Jakhama would start with Social Sciences and Humanities to publish a peer-reviewed journal
- 2. Editorial Team was constituted: Dr. Dominic Meyieho as the Editor, Dr. Medonuo Pienyu, Dr. Hormila G. Zingkhai, Dr. Khrimenuo Pusa, Dr. Fr.George Pezalhoukho Rino and Mr. James H.K as members.
- 3. The target date for publication of the 1st Issue is set on July-August, 2023.

- Herein, some of the articles that were published in the earlier journal would be published for the first issue of the journal.
- Dr. Dominic Meyieho, the Editor of the journal would initiate the process of obtaining the RNI (Registrar of Newspapers for India) and ISSN (International Standard Serial Number).

RESEARCH CELL

Date: 3rd August, 2018 Time: 1:00 pm Place: Computer Centre St. Joseph's College.

The Chairperson of the Research Cell, St. Joseph's College, Rev. Fr. Dr. Sebastian Ousepparampil convened a meeting on 3rd August, 2018 to discuss the details of the Areas of Research and the Research Proposal so as to commence the Research project/s. The meeting was chaired by Dr. Medonuo Pienyü and the following details were discussed during the meeting:

- The Research Cell of SJC will take up a project in collaboration with North Eastern Social Research Centre (NESRC), Guwahati. The members decided to seek expert guidance and logistic support from NESRC.
- 2. Though it is in its inception, the Cell will take up a Major Project.
- 3. To create an official Whatsapp Group and E-mail Id. This will be used for any official purpose with regard to the Research Cell and its related work.
- 4. The members also discussed the various feasible themes which can be taken up for the research project. The following are some of the possible themes on which the Project can be based -

i. Illegal Immigration in Nagaland ii. Impact of Cultural changes on the Naga Literature

iii. Market Transformation in Nagaland iv. Demographic study with special reference to Reproductive Rate in Nagaland v. Biodiversity of Nagaland vi. Impact of Popular Culture on the Naga Youths vii. Women Studies viii. Conflict Studies ix. Folk Culture of the Nagas

- 5. It was decided to work on the Project based on the theme 'Impact of Popular Culture on the Naga Youths' and to organise a two day National Seminar on the theme 'Illegal Immigration'. However, these are subject to changes based on the requirements of the sponsoring/funding agents as well as on the requirements of the SJC Research Cell.
- To find out the different organisations and Institutions that are sponsoring/ funding Major / Minor Projects and to apply to the same for the project.
- The Research Proposal will also include the different parameters such as Time period, Budget, tools etc., required for the project.
- 8. To publish the Research Project work in Book form.
- 9. Dr. Hormila. G. Zingkhai and Dr. Khriemenuo Pusa were nominated as the General Secretary and Finance Co-ordinator of the SJC Research Cell respectively.
