The Department of Physics, St. Joseph college (Autonomous) Jakhama under the supervision of Fr. Peter Solo the Dean of Science organised an extension program on Physics model demonstration at St. Mary's Cathedral Higher Secondary School, Kohima on the 30th of August, 2022. A total of 6 students namely Mary Yanlem, Chumbise, Mairitadbo, Nuklalienla Jamir, Sr. Angelle Shingnaisui, and Anand Dungdung, went to demonstrate the models along with the Dean of Science, Fr. Peter Solo and Ms. Sakurepla, Assistant Professor Department of Physics, SJC(A). The models were successfully demonstrated.

The students of Physics Department prepared the models under a meticulous supervision of Mr. L. Antidong Jamir, Assistant Professor, Mr. Seyienizo Benupfuno, Assistant Professor, Ms. Thejano (HoD), Mr. Melekho Chuzho, Assistant Professor, Ms. Sakurepla and with much guidance and assistance from the Dean of Science.

The extension program started at 9:30 am with a welcome address by the principal of St. Mary's Cathedral Higher Secondary School, Kohima, in their Physics lab. It was followed by an introductory note by Ms. Sakurepla, where she briefed the models. Then Sr. Angelle Shingnaisui presented a glimpse of St. Joseph's College Campus and also talked about the relevance of Physics in the fast developing world. The models, subsequently, were demonstrated to the 11th and 12th standard students of St. Mary's school. The laser experiment was showed up by Mary Yanlem, the model on electronics was exhibited by Mairitadbo, the PID control heating was displayed by chumbise, the electromyography Device was demonstrated by Nuklalienla Jamir and the Newtonian Telescope was demonstrated by Anand Dungdung. The students saw and listened to the demonstration with utmost curiosity and enthusiasm. At the end, they bombarded the demonstrators with a good number of logical questions. The demonstration was successfully concluded at 11:30 am. As a whole, the entire extension program was enriching and great learning experience for the demonstrators as well as for the students of St. Mary's School, Kohima.

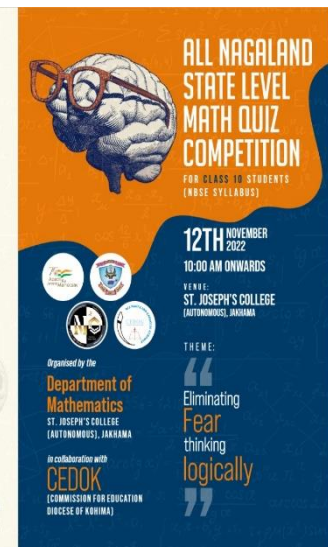
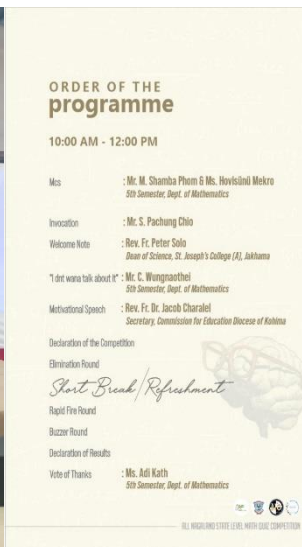


Theme: "Eliminating Fear, thinking logically"

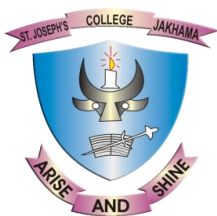

“REVISED SSR MANUAL AND BENCHMARKS FOR AUTONOMOUS COLLEGES”

The IQAC organised an orientation programme on “Revised SSR Manual and Benchmarks for Autonomous Colleges” for the management, faculties and the office staff on the 27th of April, 2023 at 12: 40 PM in the PG Conference Hall. The objective was to orient the members about the NAAC revised SSR Manual and it was attended by 119 staff of the college. The resource person for the Orientation was Dr. Fr. Gigi Thomas, Retd. Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, Mar Ivanios College (Autonomous), Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.



The orientation programme was chaired by Dr. Mhonthung Yanthan, Co-ordinator of the NAAC Steering Committee, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous). The orientation began with a welcome note by Dr. Fr. George Keduolhou Angami, the Principal of the college. He welcomed the resource person, the management, faculties and the office staff to the workshop. This was followed by a brief introduction of the Resource Person. In his address, the Principal on behalf of the college acknowledged the resource person Dr. Fr. Gigi Thomas for his time and for willingly agreeing to orient the staff of the college about the recently revised NAAC SSR Manual. Principal highlighted the pertinent need of the orientation about the revised manual as the college is in the process of applying for the 4th Cycle assessment by the NAAC. He concluded by conveying the hope that the orientation would benefit everyone present as it would create more awareness about the measures to be undertaken for quality assessment of the college and wished everyone a successful workshop.

This was followed by the orientation by Dr.Fr. Gigi Thomas, the resource person. He began by the orienting the participants about the Vision and significance of the NAAC Assessment for every HEI in the country. He highlighted the core values of NAAC as contributing to the National Development, fostering global competencies among students, inculcating a value system among students, promoting the use of technology and quest for excellence. This was followed by the explanation about the online process for Assessment & Accreditation and the steps to be followed- Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) Submission, SSR Submission and simultaneously initiating the Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and Data Validation and Verification (DVV) concurrent which will be finally followed by Peer Team Visit (PTV).

Dr. Fr. Gigi Thomas also brought out a comparative analysis of the previous and revised distribution of metrics and marks, and pointed out that though the Criteria (7 Criteria), Key Indicators (34 Key Indicators) and the Qualitative Metrics (35 Q1M) remains the same, the Quantitative Metrics (QnM) has been revised from 72 to 50, thus decreasing the Total Metrics from 107 to 85.

In addition he also elucidated on the focus areas of the assessment which is the 7 Criterion with its Key Indicators, i.e., i. Criterion I: Curricular Aspects with Key Indicators Curriculum Design and Development, Curriculum Planning and Implementation, Academic Flexibility, Curriculum Enrichment and Feedback System. ii. Criterion II: Teaching, Learning and Evaluation with Key Indicators Student Enrolment and Profile, Catering to Student Diversity, Teaching-Learning Process, Teacher Profile and Quality, Evaluation Process and Reforms, Student Performance and Learning Outcomes and Student Satisfaction Survey. iii. Criterion III: Research, Innovations and Extension with Key Indicators Promotion of Research and Facilities, Resource Mobilisation for Research,

Innovation Ecosystem, Research Publications and Awards, Consultancy, Extension Activities and Collaboration. iv. Criterion IV: Infrastructure and Learning Resources with Key Indicators Physical Facilities, Library as a Learning Resource, IT Infrastructure and Maintenance of Campus Infrastructure. v. Criterion V: Student Support and Progression with Key Indicators Student Support, Student Progression, Student Participation and Activities and Alumni Engagement. vi. Criterion VI: Governance, Leadership and Management with Key Indicators Institutional Vision and Leadership, Strategy Development and Deployment, Faculty Empowerment Strategies, Financial Management and Resource Mobilisation , and Internal Quality Assurance System. vii. Criterion VII: Institutional Values and Best Practices with Key Indicators Institutional Values and Social Responsibilities, Best Practices and Institutional Distinctiveness. The Resource Person concluded the orientation by emphasising on the need to meticulous filling of the metrics online by the institution as the marks scored by the college out of the total 1000 marks will be based on the data and details provided by the college. The orientation by the Resource Person was followed by the vote of thanks by Rev. Fr. Peter Solo, the Dean of Science. In his proposal of vote of thanks, the Dean thanked Dr. Fr. Gigi Thomas, the resource person for the orientation on the Revised NAAC SSR Manual which is the need of the hour for the college as the college readies itself for the NAAC Assessment 4th Cycle. He also expressed gratitude on behalf of the college to Dr. Fr. Thomas for his time and sharing his knowledge and experience. He concluded by thanking everyone present for their active participation, wished them the best in their effort as they work for the assessment of the college and expressed the hope that such exercise would enable the college to achieve its objectives of quality education and excellence as an educational institution.



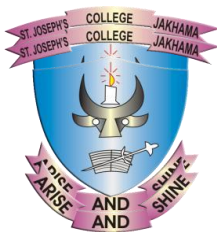

MINUTES OF THE QUALITY AUDIT CONSULTATIVE CUM EXIT MEETING

The Quality Audit Consultative cum Exit Meeting was organised by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college on 29th January, 2024 at College Conference Hall No. 1 from 12:40 PM to 3:00 PM. The meeting was attended by a total of 95 management members and faculty members and was chaired by Dr. Fr. George Keduolhou Angami, Principal, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous).

The meeting begin with an invocation by Dr. Fr. Pezalhoukho George, the PG Coordinator and this was followed by the welcome note by Dr. Fr. George Keduolhou Angami, the Principal of the college. In his welcome note, the Principal introduced the eternal expert auditor, Dr. Fr. Gigi Thomas, Associate Professor and Dean of Studies, Mar Ivanios College, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, who also has an experience as a NAAC Peer Team member. He thanked him for extending his expertise to the college and helping out the college. This was followed by a presentation on the "Observations and Recommendations" by Dr. Fr. Gigi Thomas, the Convenor of the Quality Audit Team.

Dr. Fr. Gigi Thomas highlighted the Basic Elements in a Quality System – Quality Management, Quality Control and Quality Assurance. He pointed out that leadership and commitment of top management plays a significant role in quality improvement, creating an environment for learning and staff development is crucial to do tasks right every time and adopting new philosophies and technologies can improve the quality in any institutions. For the college to have and maintain a Quality system he encouraged teamwork and participatory management, to develop a communication strategy to report progress and results, recognize the efforts of staff without creating a competitive environment, put appropriate systems and processes in place as per the needs of the stakeholders and encourage quality circles and a culture of quality among all the stakeholders.

Based on the Quality Audit observations and assessment, the Convenor of the Quality Audit presented to the staff the following:

1. CURRENT QNM STATUS FOR THE NAAC ACCREDITATION PROCESS: The

Convenor presented the overall performance of the college (Attached SSR Mock Test Report) and discussed the areas under various criteria where the college's performance was good, average and below average as per the NAAC requirements. He also shared suggestions on how the college can improve its performance.

2. **QUALITY AUDIT: OBSERVATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:** The Convenor presented the details of the Quality Audit and its observation and Recommendations based on the discussion with the team members and assessment of the NAAC SSR criterion data of the college (Attached Report of the Quality Audit)
3. **REFORMS IN THE AA PROCESS OF HEIs:** The Convenor also highlighted the recent reforms in the NAAC Accreditation System under the ambit of “**One Nation, One Data**” (**ONOD**) platform which was released on the 27th of January, 2024. The following points were the highlight of the Reforms in the AA Process of the HEIS-
 - a. **Objectives:**
 - i. To propose actionable recommendations to strengthen the accreditation processes by NAAC, NBA and the ranking system by NIRF.
 - ii. To make more institutions come into the fold of accreditation, and
 - iii. To prepare a roadmap for aligning NAAC, NBA, and NIRF to the proposed National Accreditation Council (NAC) in Higher Education Commission of India (HECI- The 4 verticals under HECI are for regulation, accreditation, funding, and academic standard setting)
 - b. **Specifics of the Reforms:**
 - i. Transition from the present 8-point grading system of NAAC to an adapted Binary Accreditation System viz., Accredited and Not Accredited Institutions
 - ii. Encourage Accredited Institutions to raise their bar, evolve in-depth or in-breadth in disciplines from ‘Level 1’ to ‘Level 4’ as Institutions of National Excellence, and then to ‘Level-5’ i.e. Institutions of Global Excellence for Multi-Disciplinary Research and Education.
 - iii. Enable Choice-based Ranking System for diverse stakeholders (students, funding agencies, industries etc.) so that potential users (students, funding agencies, industries etc.) would be enabled to make a more informed choice for studies, research and consultancy.
 - iv. Amalgamate Programme-Accreditation and Institutional-Accreditation, considering their inter-dependency and evolve a Composite Assessment System.
 - v. Mentor the Institutions falling ‘far below the standards for accreditation’. (HEIs from the accredited group may be encouraged to become mentors, with suitable credit given during their re-accreditation).
 - vi. Simplify the accreditation process, especially for the first cycle, and bring down periodicity for Re-accreditation to six years.
 - vii. Include all HEIs and every programme in the newly proposed assessment and accreditation system with due regard for their statutory dispensations.
 - viii. Consider the heterogeneity of HEIs in the country, categorise them based on their orientation/vision and heritage/legacy, and then seek information from the HEIs that are appropriate for their category (rather than a one-size-fits-all model in vogue currently).

Thus under Heritage/Legacy, the following can be considered- Old and Established, New and Upcoming Institutions and under Orientation/Vision the following may be considered- Multi-disciplinary Education and Research-Intensive,

Teaching Intensive, Research-Intensive, Specialised Streams, Vocational and Skill Intensive, Community Engagement & Service and Rural & Remote location.

- ix. Accredit with appropriate consideration for Inputs, Processes, Outcomes and Impact across different attributes of HEI (instead of more input-centric framework) encompassing (i) Curriculum (ii) Faculty Resources (iii) Learning and Teaching (iv) Research and Innovation (v) Co-curricular and extra-curricular activities (vi) Community Engagement, (vii) Green Initiatives (viii) Governance and Administration (ix) Infrastructure Development (x) Financial Resources and Management
- x. Develop a 'Unified Elicitation Tool' to collect the superset of data from HEIs for the varied purposes (of approval, accreditation, ranking) with an in-built design for collateral cross-checking to check authenticity of data and in conjunction with it, introduce maximally the technology-driven modern systems, to replace the existing manual/hybrid systems of assessment and accreditation thereby minimising subjectivity and enhancing transparency and credibility.
- xi. It is proposed to expand the **ONOD (One Nation One Data)** platform to securely capture and manage the entire super set of data used by all the agencies (AISHE, UGC, AICTE, NAAC and NBA/NIRF) with the following features: The data validation will be carried out by the involved agencies collectively using appropriate methodology. Two-way APIs shall be used by ONOD to manage the entire super set of data with high level of integrity and security. All agencies shall use the data from ONOD platform for carrying out the Approval, Assessment and Ranking. In addition, for improving the validity and reliability of the data submitted by the HEIs, a novel "Stakeholder Crowdsourcing" methodology has been proposed. The Stakeholder Crowd shall include students, faculty, alumni, industry, parents, and academic & scientific peer groups - effectively society at large, as part of the accreditation and ranking process.
- xii. Trust Institutions (along with significant penalty for wrong doings/submissions) and ensure public disclosure of relevant data in their portals by HEIs, to enhance the overall process-credibility.
- xiii. Initiate a robust outreach mechanism in tandem with effective methods of handholding the potential entrants (which is the large majority now), where the aim should be to facilitate all HEIs in the country towards joining the process of accreditation and ranking at the earliest.


The presentation was followed by the deliberation over the improvement of the data by crosschecking and collecting fresh data for the deficit metrics. Based on the deliberations it was decided that the criterion In-charges have to rework on the following:

1. **Criterion I:** (a) Check and revise the data on certificate/value added/diploma programme/online courses by including students who are taking computer courses and IGNOU courses also. (b). Check and collect data for Programmes with components of field projects.
2. **Criterion II:** (a) Revise the data on the teaching experience of the faculties (experience in other institutions can be included). (b) Revise the data on Grievances by including only those reevaluation grievances where there is an improvement of marks. (c). Cross check the result declaration date of NU (2018-2019) and revise the data.
3. **Criterion III:** (a) Cross-check and revise the SEED MONEY and other research funding by including the salary paid during MPhil/PhD Leave.
4. **Criterion IV:** Check the possibilities of improving the Student-Computer Ratio.
5. **Criterion V:** (a) Revise the data on outgoing student progression to higher education and placement. It was decided that the faculties of the departments will take the responsibility of calling the students of different passed out batch and submit the data to the criterion in-charge.
6. **Criterion VII:** (a) Revise the metrics on resource mobilization of the institution. (b) Cross check the data on FDPs/Refresher/Orientation Courses attended by the faculties.

The house also decided that after the revision of the data, the college will go for another Mock Test of SSR before deciding whether to continue with the previous process or the new process of NAAC assessment and accreditation, as the option for a roll-out from the old process is provided by the NAAC.

The meeting concluded at 3:00 PM with words of appreciation by the Principal to Dr. Fr. Gigi Thomas for his time, help and inputs and to all the faculties for their active participation in the meeting and contribution towards the improvement of the college.

REPORT OF COLLABORATION WITH PANACEA SERVICES

To enable a learning environment that supports achievement and growth with modern methods and latest technologies, the college has a state-of-the-art IT infrastructure using Microsoft Server Technology with dedicated high-end servers to manage the work stations. To manage all administrative office related works the college has developed customised software called **CAMPUS VAULT**. This software was developed in collaboration with Panacea group. It has the features to accommodate individual student profile, list and details of students according to the department and class section. The software keeps the data report of students' attendance, leave, absentees, bunking of class, hour based attendance of students, payment of instalment fees, fine, and other payments.

The college developed customized Software called **SJC EXAM SYSTEM**. It was developed by Concept Flux and installed on 16th October, 2023. It has all the features to keep record of the students pertaining to Academic & Exam matters, mark-sheets, list of students who appeared exam, not appeared, cleared, not cleared, backlog students, passed out students, and declared results of students.

The college has Wi-Fi facility with Internet Broadband speed of 30Mbps both in the Arts Block and Science Block. The teachers have access to Wi-Fi and students are provided access as and when needed. The buildings of the various blocks are interconnected using wireless radio technology to avoid network cables running across the campus. The PG Block has a separate dedicated Internet Broadband of 30Mbps and has Wi-Fi facility available in the classrooms.

For library information, Soul 3.0 from Inlibnet has been implemented and the patrons use the OPAC from the thin client systems. NComputing has been the preferred technology for desktop virtualization in the college.

Biometric Attendance System has been the model for recording attendance of Staff and also their details. There are three devices installed on each block that is Arts, Science and PG Block and are monitored from one administrative point. The data are collected through network system. The Staff can punch from any of the devices according to their location. It is not necessary that they have to punch on a specific device.

The College has well designed website, <https://stjosephjakhama.ac.in/>, powered by NK Square Team, Kohima in 2023, where all the information about the college is accessible.
