The session ended at 12:30 PM with the vote of thanks delivered by the Head of the Department.







- 5. OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAM:
 - i. It aims at giving a glimpse of options and career paths for students after graduation.
 - ii. It aims at encouraging the students to dream bigger and to explore the many various scopes that are present in pursuing Zoology as one's honours.
 - iii. It gives insight on how further studies actually works especially inside the state, within the country and outside the country.
 - iv. It aims at emphasizing the importance of making use of the available scholarships and funding by the Government especially from tribal affairs for the students in research fields.
 - v. It teaches the students moral virtues to acquire while gaining knowledge to achieve success.

6. OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAM:

The students of the 6th Semester, Department of Zoology, SJC(A), Jakhama attended the program and have acquired valuable knowledge about the scopes and areas that can be explored and pursued for further studies especially after their B.Sc. It not only cleared the doubts about areas of the subject, Zoology, but also made clear the other possible paths of career outside the subject. The students learned about the different courses in Zoology and about many qualified Universities and its eligibility criteria in which these courses can be



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taken up. Most importantly, the students learned about the agencies and jobs in which they can be employed in after their studies.

Report on Career Exploration and Awareness Talk

The Department of Zoology, SJC (A), Jakhama on the 23rd of March, 2023 organised a "Career Exploration and Awareness Talk", for the 6th Semester students of the department at the Conference Hall (PG Block), at 11:00 AM sharp in which 42 students along with the HOD of the department, Miss Rukutalu Veswuh and two other Professors attended. The program began with an invocation by Mr. Joanies Malang, B.Sc. 6th Semester, Zoology Department and a warm welcome note was then delivered by the HOD. The speaker Mr. Dr. Lilongchem Thyug was one such prodigy who in a short session covered in his talk about all the important career paths and choices of courses available for a student pursuing Zoology after B.Sc. He opened his speech with a clear deliverance of the word 'Career' and he propose for a friendly discourse. He mentioned the moral virtues students should posses to attain success. He talked about the need of more communication and interaction among students, between students and mentors and also the need to explore one's skills and strengths while equally focusing on the subject of interest. He emphasized clearly on the courses that can be taken up as a Zoologist that are available with great scopes in the state, national and international level. He also clearly highlighted many Universities, the eligibility criteria, the various job positions one can obtain on choosing a particular field of study and opportunities they can provide, the qualification needed, etc. He gave a glimpse of trending courses such as –

 M.Sc. in - Sericulture (available in the state), Museology, Marine Biology, Marine Fishery, Marine Science, Microbiology, Wildlife, Forensic Science, Oceanography (outside the country)

Heencouraged the students to utilise the scholarships and funding available to help assist those in research fields and in high profile Universities, both in and out of the country. He talked about other conventional career paths outside the subject such as Basic training programs like DMLT (Diploma in Medical Lap Technology), B.Ed. and M.Ed., other skill enhancement programs outside academics and competitive exams which when driven with zeal, hard work and determination can be a very worthy and highly valued career choices. He lastly mentioned about the importance of having clear interaction between parents, about making clear and wise choice of career and the significance of binding one's struggles and achievements by prayer for a fruitful and successful life.
