## AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON "CYBER SECURITY & EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES"

National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT), Kohima in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Jakhama, organised an awareness program on "*Cyber Security & Emerging Technologies*" on 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2022, at the College Indoor Stadium from 12:40 P.M to 2:40 P.M.

Mr. A. Morimenba Amer, Joint Director/ Scientist 'D', NIELIT, Kohima, Mr. Moasunep Kichu, Technical Assistant, NIELIT, Kohima were the resource persons for the programme. 1200 students of the 5<sup>th</sup> semester of the under-graduate course and 16 faculty members along with the Principal and Vice-Principal (Academic Affairs) attended the programme.

On 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2022, the programme started with an address of welcome by Dr. Fr. George Keduolhou Angami, Principal, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous). On behalf of the college, he welcomed the resource persons and the team from NIELIT and all the participants present. He addressed the participants by emphasising on the importance of the awareness program as the need of the hour since "we are living in a digitalised world where technology plays a very significant role in our life". This was followed by the talk on "Cyber Security" by Mr. Morimenba Amer, Joint Director, NIELIT, Kohima. The Resource person drew attention to the different types of cyber crime such as Identity Theft, Social Engineering, Social Media related Attacks, Digital Banking Frauds, Attacks through Mobile Applications, and Virus Attacks on Personal Computer. He also shared the different practices to follow to be secure from all such cyber attacks and what steps should be taken incase we become victims of such cyber crimes. This was followed by the talk by the second Resource Person, Mr. Moasunep Kichu, Technical Assistant, NIELIT, Kohima, who spoke about the different emerging technologies. The different technologies such as Internet of Things, Virtual Reality, Artificial Intelligence, Blockchain, 3D Printing & Modelling, Big Data Analysis, Robotic Process Automation, Web, Mobile Development & Marketing, Cloud Computing and Cyber Security are the real game changers in


the modern world and in how we do things and carry out our lives. He discussed the significance of the different technologies and how the institution and the students and faculty members can utilise the technologies for different educational and personal purposes.

Entry of Details on the Cover Page of the Answer Script

the top right side in every page of the scripts

Students should write the exam in **his/her own handwriting** legibly

#### SUBMISSION OF ANSWER SCRIPTS

- Scan your handwritten answer scripts and save it in Portrait Format
- Convert it to a single PDF file (Page wise)
- Save the file with the File name comprising of your Roll No and Course Code. For example, <u>19MSOC097 MSOC 2.1</u>
- Compress the PDF File to <u>5MB-7MB (Maximum)</u>
- Submit /upload your answer scripts PDF File to the subject teacher within the allotted time through email, WhatsApp, google classroom app etc., as per instruction of your teacher

- The time of Examination: <u>9:30 am to 12:30 noon</u>.
- The respective subject teacher will send the Question Papers to the students by <u>9:20 am</u>.
- Upload the answer script on or before <u>1:30pm</u>
