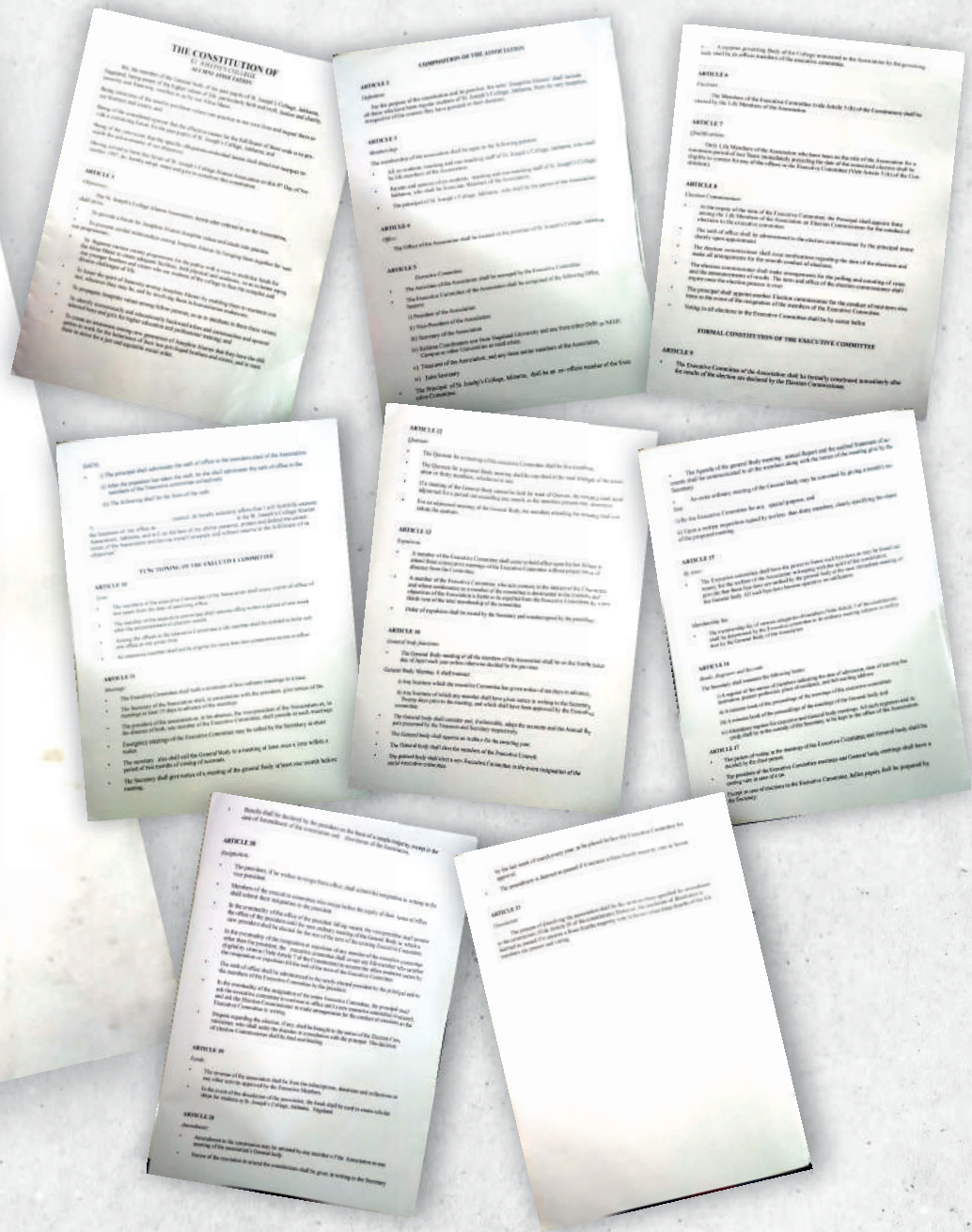

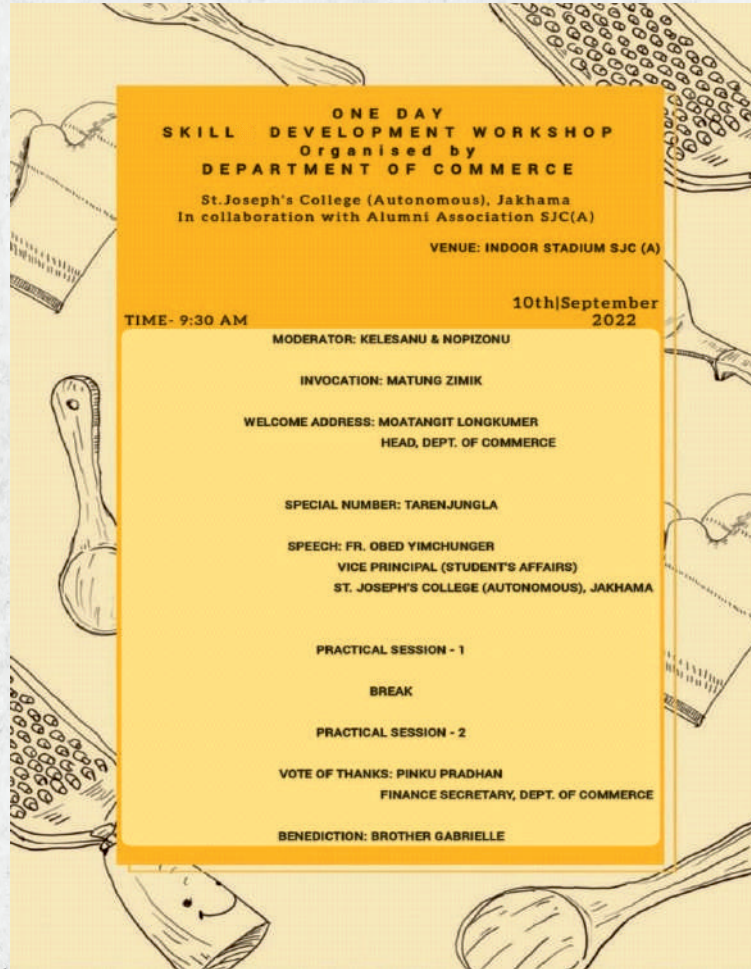
ICSSR-NER SPONSORED REGIONAL WORKSHOP

REPORT ON ONE DAY SKILL DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP ON 'BAKING AND PICKLE MAKING'

The Department of Commerce, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Jakhama in collaboration with Alumni Association SJC(A) conducted a one-day workshop on skill development for all the Commerce student on 10th September,

2022 at the college indoor stadium on the topic 'Baking and Pickle Making'. The resource persons for the workshop on baking were: Miss Neetu Sigh and Miss Katini Sunar the alumni of Commerce Department and the resource person for pickle making were Mrs. Thejanuo Fidelia and Mrs Supongnungla Kichu.

All the Commerce students attended the workshop. Altogether there were 252 participants out of which 136 were boys and 116 were girls attended the workshop. It is a systematic program that is organized annually for the students with the objective to teach the students various hand on skills that they can utilize to make something useful on their own and also even to the extent of earning a livelihood for themselves. Different skills are simultaneously taught so the students can pick any skill of their interests and learn from different resource persons.

The skill development workshop is a carefully planned effort to teach students outside of the syllabus. It is aimed to make the students learn basic life based skills which enable the students to make something useful and earn money on their own during their leisure time. The uniqueness of the program is that it is purely based on practical activity where the students are all made to learn and also do it on their own which will be assessed later.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1) To provide a platform among students, the first-hand experience of baking and making pickle.
- 2) To provide the students, the ingredients to prepare various types of products like cakes cookies, meat pickle, chili pickle etc
- 3) To teach the student with different technique how to make pickle and bake cake with and without oven.
- 4) To help students earn their own pocket money and a livelihood for themselves

Outcome:

- 1) The students can witness personally how different varieties of cakes are baked as well as how pickles are prepared.
- 2) The students should be able to remember the list of ingredients needed to make various types of cakes and pickles.
- 3) Should able to calculate the cost of baking cake and making pickles.
- 4) The students should be able to bake cakes with and without oven as well as make pickle by themselves at home for their personal use as well as for sales.

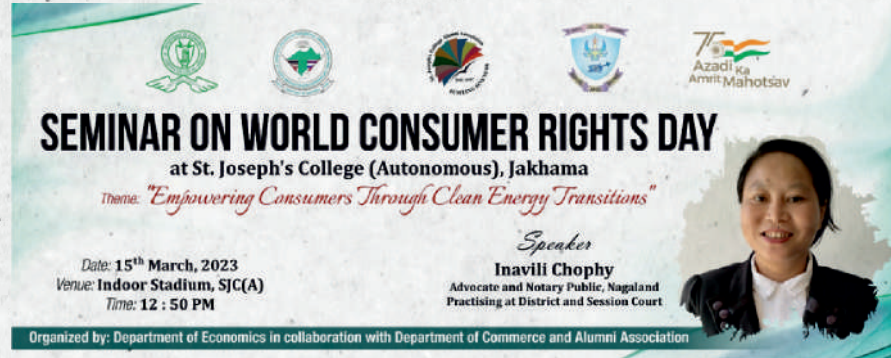

Addressing the gathering as the speaker, Advocate Inavili Choppy, spoke on how there was an impact on Indian Economy during Covid-19 lockdown which led to increase in unemployment to 24%.

She also talked about how a country like India could influence clean energy transition and to support economic recovery through clean energy.

Chophy emphasised that India can gradually reduce its exposure to community imports and foreign-supply chains through distributed energy systems and the promotion of domestic manufacturing.

She ended her speech saying that circular economy solutions linked with clean energy should become a core feature of India's future economy.

The programme started with invocation by Sister Vitsonino and welcome address by President, Department of Economics, Vishekhoto and culminated with vote of thanks by Vice President of Alumni Association, Moatangit Longkumer.

REPORT ON SILVER JUBILEE CELEBRATION OF ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

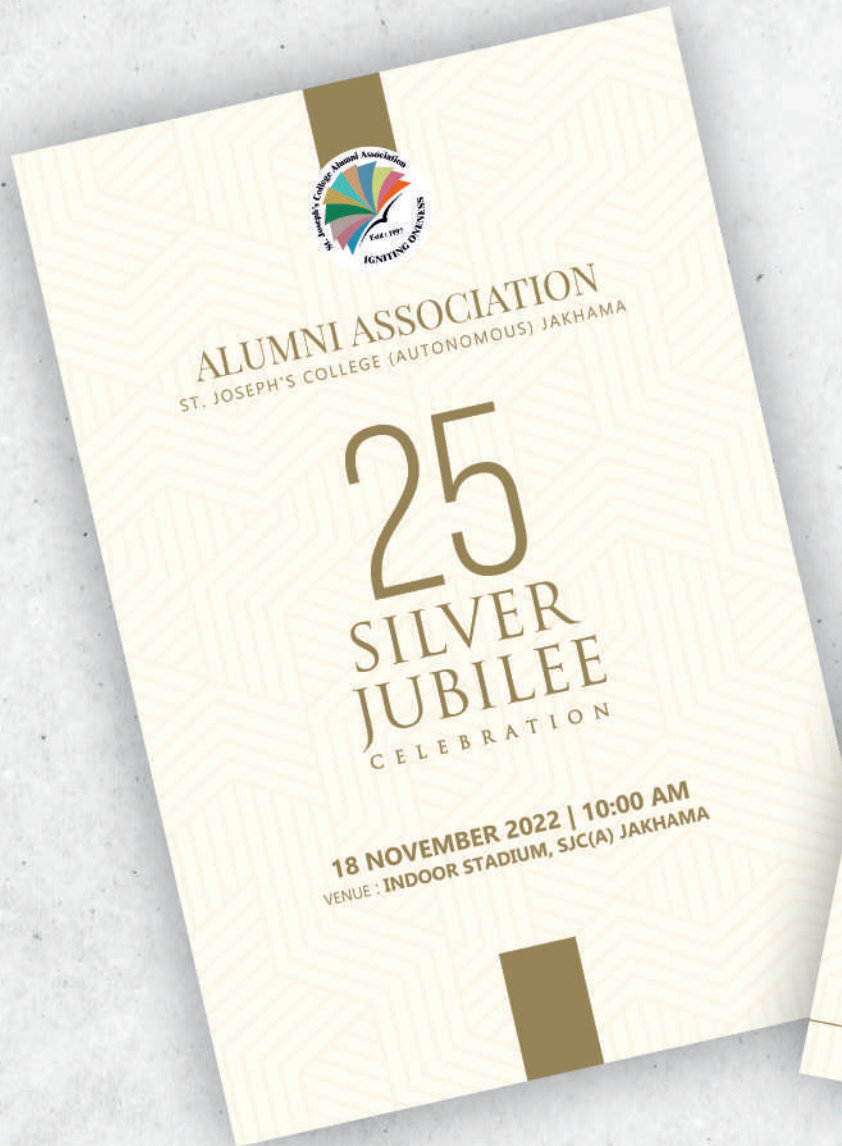

Alumni Association of St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Jakhama, celebrated its Silver Jubilee under the theme "Igniting Oneness" on Friday the 18th November 2022 at the college campus in Kohima. While pronouncing the invocation prayer, Rev. Dr. Fr. George Keduolhou Angami, principal of the college, stated that the Alumni meet-cum-celebration of 25th anniversary of the association was an opportunity to celebrate "One love and one heart". The college's principal, a 1985 batch, went on to state that the fundamental reason why they have alumni meet was to create opportunity for the college to show love and affection towards their former graduate students and to celebrate their achievements. Also speaking at the event, Advocate and first president of the college Alumni Association, Mr Kezhokhoto Savi, recalled that in the year 1997, the then college principal invited few of them to form the alumni association. He informed that it was on November 8, 1997, that the association was formed. Savi, a student of 1985 (first batch), also stressed on the need to help others while asking the alumni not to be complacent with whatever knowledge they have gained so far but rather have the curiosity to learn by a student lifetime. "It is not too late or too early to learn anything," he added. The association president, I Yanger Imchen, stated that the association produced many officers since its inception. Guest speaker Shri Thejawelie Gregory (IAS), Commissioner of State Taxes, has expressed happiness that the college has tremendously developed over the years. Acknowledging their principal and a team of lecturers for making them become responsible and successful citizens in their life and society, he reminded the students that there is no substitute to hard work. Gregory said that every individual is meant to play different roles in the society while stressing on the need to be an agents of change in their community as well as the state. "Let's try to practice what we have learnt and lead our lives by examples," he said. Apprising how their association has strength of 37,000 members from few individuals and has come a long way, he asked all concern to take their association forward while celebrating the jubilee. Dr. Medonuo Pienyii, Co-Convenor, jubilee planning committee, paid tribute to the ex-officials of the alumni association, young professional in different fields from the college and present students who brought laurels to the college. On the occasion, Keneisezo Thomas Belho, an upcoming entrepreneur and PG student from Sociology department, also introduced his eco-friendly products. 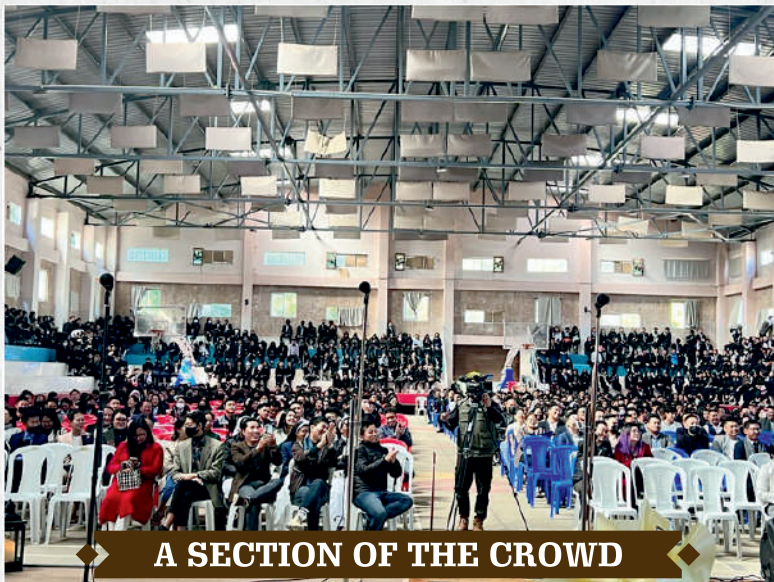
