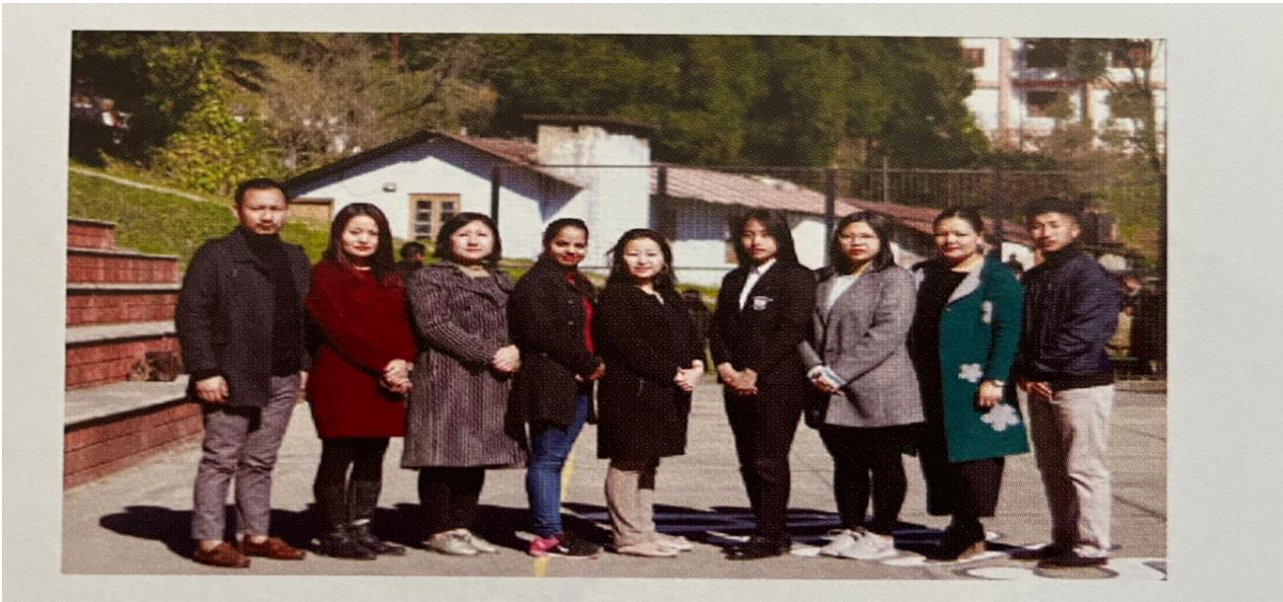

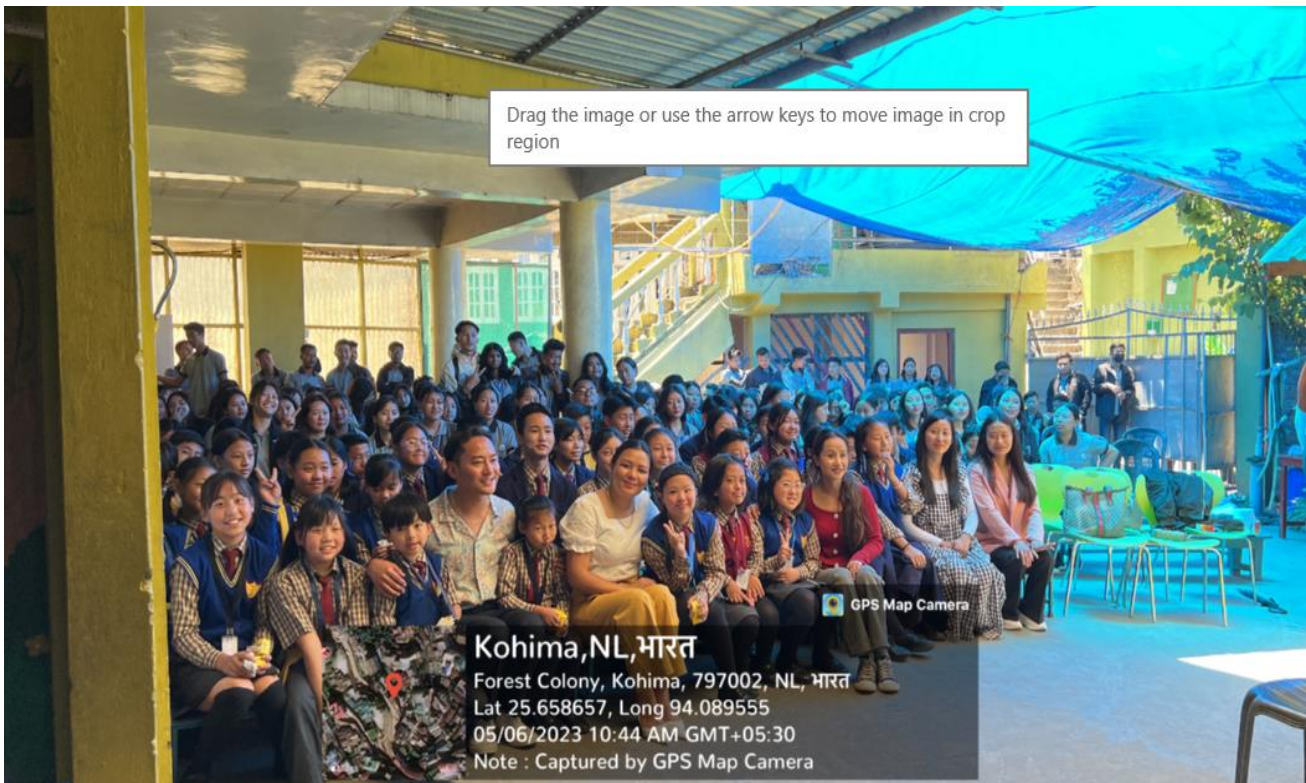

Gracing the first session

as the guest speaker, Rev Dr Chingmak Chang, secretary, Eleutheros Christian Society Tuensang expressed happiness over the concept of Spring Fest, which enables the young people to exhibit their talents. "I think that is very unique in itself," he said.

He said that young people are the spring in their

lifetime, adding that "this is the season where you have to prepare yourselves."

He said that companies around the world are beginning to see that the employees whose characters are reliable. In this, he called upon the students to build up their character to secure a successful life. "You ought

to build up your character," he said and also told the students to be honest and hard-working person.

liefs, folklores, culture, unity and harmony, he said "solidarity is our team spirit as Josephite."

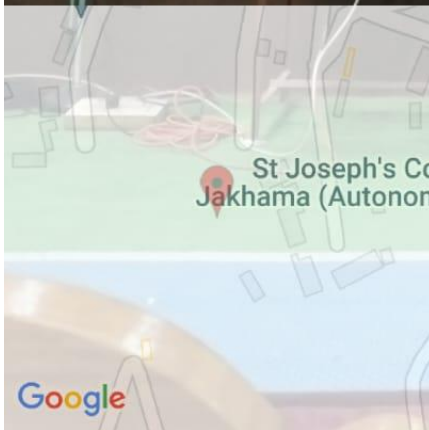
