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

Students of St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Jakhama extension program at St. Mary's Cathedral Hr. Sec. School, Kohima

The Department of Physics, St. Joseph college (Autonomous) Jakhama under the supervision of Fr. Peter Solo the Dean of Science organised an extension program on Physics model demonstration at St. Mary's Cathedral Higher Secondary School, Kohima on the 30th of August, 2022. A total of 6 students namely Mary Yanlem, Chumbise, Mairitadbo, Nuklaienla Jamir, Sr. Angelle Shingnaisui, and Anand Dungdung, went to demonstrate the models along with the Dean of Science, Fr. Peter Solo and Ms. Sakurepla, Assistant Professor Department of Physics, SJC(A). The models were successfully demonstrated.

The students of Physics Department prepared the models under a meticulous supervision of Mr. L. Antidong Jamir, Assistant Professor, Mr. Seyienizo Benupfuno, Assistant Professor, Ms. Thejano (HoD), Mr. Melekho Chuzho, Assistant Professor, Ms. Sakurepla and with much guidance and assistance from the Dean of Science.

The extension program started at 9:30 am with a welcome address by the principal of St. Mary's Cathedral Higher Secondary School, Kohima, in their Physics lab. It was followed by an introductory note by Ms. Sakurepla, where she briefed the models. Then Sr. Angelle Shingnaisui presented a glimpse of St. Joseph's College Campus and also talked about the relevance of Physics in the fast developing world. The models, subsequently, were demonstrated to the 11th and 12th standard students of St. Mary's school. The laser experiment was showed up by Mary Yanlem, the model on electronics was exhibited by Mairitadbo, the PID control heating was displayed by chumbise, the electromyography Device was demonstrated by Nuklaienla Jamir and the Newtonian Telescope was demonstrated by Anand Dungdung. The students saw and listened to the demonstrators with a good number of logical questions. The demonstration was successfully concluded at 11:30 am. As a whole, the entire extension program was enriching and great learning experience for the demonstrators as well as for the students of St. Mary's School, Kohima.



Distinctiveness and Inter-connectivity of Ethnic Identity, Tribe and Clan Manifestation in the Northeast India

Abstract

The Northeast India stands out for its uniqueness and richness in ethnic background, cultural vibrancy, tribal distinctiveness, clan manifestation, linguistic variance, and religious diversity. The region is regarded as one of the hotspots of ethnic assertiveness in retaining and protecting their distinct identities having complex historical background over the centuries. The ethnic issue involved not just the natives within the Indian subcontinent, but also a fight against illegal immigration.

The Northeastern states developed a keen feeling of nationality as an outcome of real kinship founded on clan affiliations rather than fictive kinship. While the dominant tribal group fostered clan activism among its members by acting as a functioning kinship group and instilling a sense of camaraderie, the minority groups are also inspired to work together as a group of competent kinship units, oftentimes in contradictions to other clan, which eventually promotes the growth of clan activism. The emergence of comparable institutions that permit people to transit across ethnic lines is underlined by the significance of the clan presence amongst many tribes. The aforementioned unparalleled but intriguing analysis elevates multiple questions concerning the region's ethnogenesis and assertion of rigorous ethnic identity.

Impact of Globalisation on Cultural Distinctiveness among the Tribals in North East of India

Abstract

Each tribal community in the north east region of India claims cultural distinctiveness vis-à-vis other communities tribal or otherwise - that in turn serves as the basis of identity formation and assertion. There is a historical antecedent to such claims as the tribals of yore lived in separate clusters with minimal inter-tribal interactions. However, there have been forces of change from within and without, mostly outside their control, that dent the claim to such distinctiveness and bring the entire tribal groups of the region, more or less, under the same umbrella in time and space. The British colonialism and the accompanying spread of Christianity and imposition of western education among the tribals opened the floodgate to epochmaking changes among the tribals that eventually paved the way to the path of globalization. India's independence and the transplantation of liberal democratic polity had a paradigmatic impact on the tribals by undermining the tribal practices with hitherto alien practices. India's economic liberalization in the last decade of the twentieth century completes the runway to the fast-track lane of globalization from which there is no return. This paper focuses on the impact of globalization on the cultural practices of the tribals in two major and somewhat contradictory ways: the sharpening of tribal distinctiveness and emergence tribal fraternity among the different tribal groups.



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



This was followed by the orientation by Dr.Fr. Gigi Thomas, the resource person. He began by the orienting the participants about the Vision and significance of the NAAC Assessment for every HEI in the country. He highlighted the core values of NAAC as contributing to the National Development, fostering global competencies among students, inculcating a value system among students, promoting the use of technology and quest for excellence. This was followed by the explanation about the online process for Assessment & Accreditation and the steps to be followed-Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) Submission, SSR Submission and simultaneously initiating the Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and Data Validation and Verification (DVV) concurrent which will be finally followed by Peer Team Visit (PTV).



Gigi Thomas also brought out a comparative analysis of the previous and revised distribution of metrics and marks, and pointed out that though the Criteria (7 Criteria), Key Indicators (34 Key Indicators) and the Qualitative Metrics (35 Q1M) remains the same, the Quantitative Metrics (QnM) has been revised from 72 to 50, thus decreasing the Total Metrics from 107 to 85.

In addition he also elucidated on the focus areas of the assessment which is the 7 Criterion with its Key Indicators, i.e., i. Criterion I: Curricular Aspects with Key Indicators Curriculum Design and Development, Curriculum Planning and Implementation, Academic Flexibility, Curriculum Enrichment and Feedback System. ii. Criterion II: Teaching, Learning and Evaluation with Key Indicators Student Enrolment and Profile, Catering to Student Diversity, Teaching-Learning Process, Teacher Profile and Quality, Evaluation Process and Reforms, Student Performance and Learning Outcomes and Student Satisfaction Survey. iii. Criterion III: Research, Innovations and Extension with Key Indicators Promotion of Research and Facilities, Resource Mobilisation for Research, Innovation Ecosystem, Research Publications and Awards, Consultancy, Extension

Activities and Collaboration, iv. Criterion IV: Infrastructure and Learning Resources with Key Indicators Physical Facilities, Library as a Learning Resource, IT Infrastructure and Maintenance of Campus Infrastructure. v. Criterion V: Student Support and Progression with Key Indicators Student Support, Student Progression, Student Participation and Activities and Alumni Engagement. vi. 
Collaboration between Global Holistic Health, Research and Training Institute, Jalukie And St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Jakhama

REPORT OF COLLABORATION WITH PANACEA SERVICES

To enable a learning environment that supports achievement and growth with modernmethods and latest technologies, the college has a state-of-the-art IT infrastructure using Microsoft Server Technology with dedicated high-end servers to manage the work stations. To manage all administrative office related works the college has developed customised software called **CAMPUS VAULT.** This software was developed in collaboration with Panacea group. It has the features to accommodate individual student profile, list and details of students according to the department and class section. The software keeps the data report of students' attendance, leave, absentees, bunking of class, hour based attendance of students, payment of instalment fees, fine, and other payments.

The college developed customized Software called **SJC EXAM SYSTEM.** It was developed by Concept Flux and installed on 16th October, 2023. It has all the features to keep record of the students pertaining to Academic & Exam matters, mark-sheets, list of students who appeared exam, not appeared, cleared, not cleared, backlog students, passed out students, and declared results of students.

The college has Wi-Fi facility with Internet Broadband speed of 30Mbps both in the Arts Block and Science Lock. The teachers have access to Wi-Fi and students are provided access as and when needed. The buildings of the various blocks are interconnected using wireless radio technology to avoid network cables running across the campus. The PG Block has a separate dedicated Internet Broadband of 30Mbps and has Wi-Fi facility available in the classrooms.

For library information, Soul 3.0 from Inflibnet has been implemented and the patrons use the OPAC from the thin client systems. NComputing has been the preferred technology for desktop virtualization in the college.

Biometric Attendance System has been the model for recording attendance of Staff and also their details. There are three devices installed on each block that is Arts, Science and PG Block and are monitored from one administrative point. The data are collected through network system. The Staff can punch from any of the devices according to their location. It is not necessary that they have to punch on a specific device.


