

Date: 17th August, 2019

The Board of Studies meeting of the Department of Business Administration, St. Joseph's College Autonomous, Jakhama, Nagaland, was held on 17th August, 2019, in the College Conference Hall. The first BOS meeting was convened in order to fulfil the guidelines of the University Grant Commission as well as to review the current curriculum of the Business Administration course under the SJC autonomous.

The Following members were present for the BOS meeting:

- - 1. Mr. K. Zubemo Humtsoe: Chairman of the BOS
 - 2. Dr. Manoj Prabhakar, School of Management, Nagaland University, Member Nominee from the University
 - 3. Md. Tabrei, Member
 - 4. Mr. Imtipong Longkumer, Member
 - 5. Ms. Wecho-u Mero, Member
 - 6. Ms. Nensiya Kath, Member.

Lengthy discussions on the current curriculum structure of the BBA Undergraduate course under Autonomous has led to the development of more relevant and up to date syllabi which will definitely enable the students to enhance their knowledge and skills that can meet the need and requirements of the contemporary business enterprises. The following discussions were made during the BOS meeting for recommendation to the Academic Council of the College:

1. Revision of the Curriculum Structure: The present curriculum structure consist of 26 papers/subjects with 140 credit points in total, which was drawn in totality from the model provided by the University Grant Commission. The high credit points allotted to few papers has restricted the inclusion of more papers/subjects which are relevant and inevitable to meet the demands of business enterprises in the present time. Therefore, the members of the BOS, thoroughly discussed on these pertinent issues and to recommend the proposed revised Curriculum Structure to be implemented from the next academic year, i.e. June 2020, onwards to the Academic Council of the College for approval. It was also noted that the current curriculum is inadequate, therefore, revision is proposed so that the business students are given enough exposure to core and relevant business subjects thereby enhancing their knowledge, skills and abilities. The members of the BOS were unanimous on the inclusion of more relevant business subjects in the curriculum and not merely focus on the total Credit Points reflected in the curriculum.

The detail of the proposed revised structure is presented in the following table:

- 2. The BOS made clarification on the Credit Points: Since business management course falls under the technical course as per the definition of the AICTE (All India Council of Technical Education), and based on the need and uniqueness of the course, it is not necessary to follow uniform maximum credit points like the other non-technical courses. Therefore, the members of the Board of studies had made serious study on allotment of credit points on the proposed subjects after making comparative study with other institutions/universities in India providing the same course.
- 3. <u>Credit Points on Generic Elective Papers</u>: Since the students of the Department of Business Administration goes to other Departments for the Generic Elective subjects and avail 6 credit points each in total, it requires the Department of Business Administration to maintain uniformity in this regard by allotting 6 Credit Points to the students of other Departments enrolled in the BBA Generic Elective subjects.
- 4. Renaming of Subjects: The renaming of some subjects was initiated based on its relevance and nomenclature associated with its use in the contemporary business enterprises. The syllabus will remain the same.
- Shifting of Subjects across various Semesters: Shifting of subjects was proposed based on the learning requirements at each semester, i.e. from basics/fundamentals to core business concepts and practices.
- 6. <u>Additional Subjects</u>: To fill up the gap of the current curriculum, few relevant subjects were added to the revised curriculum. This will give much advantage to the business students in the contemporary times. The addition of some important and relevant subjects was inevitable. Altogether, 6 new subjects were added in the proposed revised curriculum structure.

The first Board of Studies meeting of the Department of Business Department was fruitful and the members of the BOS are hopeful that the College authority and the Academic council of the College will support in its effort to provide relevant and up-to-date curriculum to give advantage to the students as well as to raise the standard of the curriculum.

The First Meeting of the Board of Studies was held on 9th February, 2019 at 10.00am in the Department office of Commerce.

Mrs. Thejanuo Fidelia, HoD., presented the draft syllabus on the course structure prepared by the staff based on UGC course structure and the syllabus for common discussion, modification, and finalization which will be presented in the Academic Council. A copy of the course structure as approved by the BUGS is attached with this. The approved course structure is in accordance to the UGC pattern of syllabus.

Accordingly the syllabus contains:

- 1. 14 Core Courses of 6 credits each with a total of (14papers x 6 credits) 84 credits of the core courses.
- 2. 2 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses with 2 Credits each (2 papers x 2 credits) a total of 4 credits.
- 3. 2 Skill Enhancement courses with 2 credits each (2 papers x 2 credits) a total of 4 credits.
- 4. 4 Discipline Specific Elective Courses with 6 credits each (4 papers x 6 credits) a total of 24 credits.
- 5. 4 Generic Elective Courses with 6 credits each (4 papers x 6 credits) a total of 24 credits.
- 6. The course will carry a total of 140 Credits.

Modifications made to the syllabus:

BCH-6.2 Indirect Tax Law (Discipline Specific Elective Courses with 6 credits) was modified with the Goods and Service Tax Law (GST). The syllabus as approved by the member of the BUGS is attached.

Further, the approval of the course structure, its contents of the syllabus taking into account each units of the syllabus was presented by the HoD through power point and after thorough discussions and necessary modifications was finalized for presentation in the Academic Council meeting. The meeting ended at 3.00pm.

The meeting for the Board of Studies was called on 2nd August, 2019, wherein Dr. Talijungla Ao, Associate Professor, Nagaland University, Department of Botany was invited for the deliberation and approval of the new CBCS syllabus at St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Botany Department (Science Block), Jakhama. The meeting was chaired by Ms.Neithongunuo Angela Belho, Assistant Professor, H.O.D of Botany Department.

The meeting began with an invocation by Mrs. Imkongyala Sekhose followed by welcome address by Ms. Neithongunuo Angela Belho and introduction by the staff of Botany Department.

Deliberation of the new CBCS syllabus.

- Discussion of CBCS syllabus began with Dr. Talijungla Ao advising on the restructuring of syllabus, if any to be made after 3 years as given by the UGC guidelines.
- On the topic of skill enhancement, it was advised that students should be given the choice to choose from the given topics along with a 2nd option.
- Based on their scores, students will be allotted their skill enhancement topic if majority of them opt for the same topic.
- Due to the absence of a food microbiologist, it was advised to be taken up if a specialist is present in the near future.
- Certain changes in the name of the topics were discussed in skill enhancement course
 after the next revision (i.e. after 3 years) such as Herbal Technology, as it includes a
 much broader term and therefore, studies related to locally available medicinal plants are
 to be considered.

- On mushroom culture, the word cultivation could be more appropriate wherein, the house unanimously decided on edible mushroom both cultivated as well as wild edible mushrooms.
- Changes in the next revision on the names of mushrooms specified in the present syllabus such as few edible mushrooms in India.
- An ethnobotanical study was highly recommended for skill enhancement course.
- Due to 2 credits in skill enhancement course, the house decided that demonstrations, self help groups, student's field trip or PowerPoint presentation or any method related to the course could be considered for further development of the student.
- In core course 1 it was also advised to restructure the name of the paper, stressing on viruses and bacteria in microbiology i.e. Phycology and Microbiology (Viruses and Bacteria).
- On deliberation of Generic eclectics, it was advised that some units/topics can be similar with core courses but its entirety is not recommended.
- Evaluation with other college syllabus such as Kohima Science College and Patkai Christian College were also deliberated where, Patkai Christian College and St. Joseph's College (Autonomous) Jakhama had the same credit points (140 credits).
- Credits given within the guidelines of UGC should not be exceeded.
- Justification required or should be accompanied on why a unit or topic was added or deleted.
- Assessment of students throughout the semester was highly advised.
- Dr. Talijungla gave a word of encouragement and approved the new CBCS syllabus.
- The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by Mrs. Payal Bose.



First Meeting of the Board of studies was held on 7th February, 2019 at 1.00 pm in the college Conference Hall. The following members were present in the meeting.

Mr. Saju Mathew, HoD., presented the draft syllabus and the course structure prepared by the staff based on UGC course structure and the syllabus for common discussion, modification, and finalization which will be presented in the Academic Council. A copy of the course structure approved by the BUGS is attached with this. This course structure is in the same pattern of the UGC syllabus. Accordingly there will be 14 core courses and each paper will carry 6 credits each which mean a total of (14 papers ×6 credits) 84 credit for the core courses. There will be two ability enhancement compulsory courses each paper carries two credit each which means (2papers × 2credit) a total of 4 credits. Two skill enhancement courses will be there with each paper carrying two credit each (2papers × 2credit) and a total of four credit for skill enhancement courses. There will be four discipline specific elective which can be chosen from a pool of papers given and each paper will carry six credit each and a total of 24 credit. The Generic Elective papers will be inter disciplinary. Economics students can choose four papers (generic elective) from any other discipline and not from economics itself. Each generic elective paper will carry 6 credits each and a total of 24 credits. So the course will carry a total of 140 credits. Students from other departments can choose economic generic elective papers.

After the approval of course structure, syllabus of each paper was presented one by one with the help of power point and after the discussion and necessary modification each paper was finalized for the presentation in the Academic council meeting. For the uniformity of all the papers it was unanimously decided to make all the papers (six credits) with four chapters and each chapter carries 25 marks each. The meeting was ended by at 2. 40 pm.

The following decisions were arrived at during the meeting. As and when time comes for setting of the semester end exams, the following pattern of questions will be in place:

- 1. For the Core Courses, there will be four (4) questions of 14 marks and two (2) questions of 7 marks. There will be options for each of these questions and each unit will carry equal value of marks. Internal carries total of 30 marks out which 13.5 will be pass mark and External carries total of 70 marks out of which 31.5 will be pass marks.
- 2. For the Ability Enhancement and AE Skill Based courses the total marks of 50 will be divided into two portions: 15 marks for internal out of which 8 will be the pass marks. 35 marks will be external out of which 18 will be the pass marks. The question will consist following: a. Very short type (1X3=3). b. Short Question type (3X3=9). c. Moderate question (6X3=18). D. Descriptive type (10X2=20) Total: 50 marks.
- 3. For Discipline Specific Elective courses, the question pattern and marks distribution will remain the same as that of Core Courses. Internal carries total of 30 marks out which 13.5 will be pass mark and External carries total of 70 marks out of which 31.5 will be pass marks.
- 4. And as for the Generic Elective papers, the distribution of Internal and External marks will remain the same as that of Core Course papers and Discipline Specific papers i.e. External: 70 and Internal: 30 out of which 31.5 and 13.5 will be the pass marks respectively.

Minutes of the Board of Studies meeting for review:

The review meeting of the Board of Studies (Dept. of English) was convened on 24th June, at the Conference Hall at 12: 30 pm in the presence of the University Nominee (Subject Expert), Prof. Jano S Legiese. This meeting came in need of as the ball has been rolled into the court with the start of CBCS syllabi for the first Semester Students from the Academic session, 2019-2020. The meeting started with the welcome note and presentation to Prof. Jano S Legiese. Then Fr. Dr. Joy led the invocation of God's presence for the programme.

The following discussions followed during the meeting:

- 1. Mr. James H.K (outgoing HOD) highlighted the contents of the CBCS syllabi, credits for each paper and contact hours.
- 2. Prof. Jano S Legiese raised the question on whether the 20% change in the syllabus can be done completely for one paper and further stated that there is no clear-cut instruction from the UGC. She agreed with the topics that the Dept. had adopted and suggested that there could also be inclusion of a literary theory paper like Post colonial theories and feminist theories. She was also of interest in the Research Methodology. She also was of the opinion that we could get in touch with Kohima Science College as they are the first college to implement CBCS syllabus in the college.
- 3. The house went ahead in discussing matters about marks distribution for two Credits papers and the enrollment of students from the other departments for the Generic Elective papers. James H.K remarked that for practical reasons, only the number of the department students can the Generic Elective papers be offered to the other students as well.
- 4. Mr. Jude pointed out the slight difficulty of setting the questions. HOD added that such difficulty came due to short span of time for class and early internal examinations which are conducted when not too many portions of the syllabus have been covered.
- 5. Further discussions and review shifted to how the students are coping up with the new syllabus particularly for the Core Courses. The house expressed that it is challenging for the teachers as well as for the students as the syllabus is new. Regarding Ability Enhancement paper, MmeZulusenla remarked that the students are coping up well. Regarding CC2, Ms. Tainla shared that since the students are so used to poems and stories, classical literature is a little taxing for the students.
- 6. Fr. Joy Thomas SVD highlighted the syllabus for MA English and stated that it has already been approved by the UGC. And Madam Jano suggested comparative studies, question pattern and its setting.
- 7. The meeting came to an end with the note from HOD that the Meeting of the Board of Studies has to happen at least once every semester to review and give suggestions as we are just starting and the members agreed to have the next meeting sometime in the month of October, 2019.

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REPORT OF THE FIRST BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING

DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

Time- 11.00 AM

Date- 28th June, 2019

Venue-Conference Hall, SJC

The meeting was chaired by Mr. Zeneikho Pfukha and with Ms. Lucy Kamei as the recording Secretary. It was attended by ten faculty members, the Principal, Fr. Dr. Sebastian Ousepparampil and Vice Principal, Sr. Dr. Ranit.

After the invocation by Sr. Ancy, there was a brief introduction of the Subject Expert, Dr. Aokumla Walling from the Nagaland University (Dept of History and Archaeology) and the faculty members. A brief speech was also delivered by the Principal, Fr. Dr. Sebastian Ousepparampil in which he emphasized on the relevance and importance of CBCS. He also talked about the importance of undertaking minor research works with the students as that can be beneficial for both students and teachers. The speech was followed by the briefing of the CBCS syllabus where discussions were made concerning the necessary changes and adjustments to be made.

THE MEETING MINUTES

- Dr. Walling urged the faculty to add more specific topics to the first unit (Pre-History) of Paper II (Social Formations and Cultural patterns of the Ancient World)
- 2. It was also suggested that more specific topics had to be highlighted regarding Unit III of Paper II so that students will understand and prepare better.
- 3. Regarding HIS- 301 (History of India- III 750 -1206), it had been suggested that within the unit heading, specific topics had to be included to maintain uniformity and clarity instead of being vague.
- 4. From HIS- 302 (Rise of the Modern west- I), Unit V, Dr. Walling suggested the topic on Russia to be removed.
- 5. HIS- 402 (Rise of the Modern West-II) is opened to further changes.
- 6. With regard to HIS- 403 Political History of the Nagas), there are no changes required on the syllabus but Dr. Walling cautioned that there could be many new books and researches made, so it was advised that the faculty and the library is well updated.
- 7. With regard to Skill Enhancement Course, paper I (Understanding Heritage), Dr. Walling emphasized on making the syllabus and topics more 'Local-centric' and to put topics which are more in sync with Nagaland and her culture. It has been suggested that students are taught about the significance of conservation, preservation and protection so that an authentic study of our heritage and culture is made.
- 8. It had been agreed that Skill Enhancement Course Paper II (Archives and Museums) had to be restructured.
- Regarding Discipline Specific Elective IX (History of Modern East Asia- I and II), Dr. Walling said she will
 discuss the papers and its contents with her colleagues at Nagaland University after which necessary
 changes or additions can be discussed.
- 10. With regard to Generic Elective Courses, Dr. Walling insisted that we maintain the 5 units pattern in all the papers.
- 11. From Generic Elective paper III, it was decided that the topic on 'Mewar' will be removed and will be replaced by the history of the Ahom kingdoms.
- 12. Dr. Walling urged the college to create a syllabus that will help the students for competitive exams and NET.
- 13. The importance of giving the Publisher and year of Publishing in the essential reading lists was made so as to be more professional and specific.

14. Dr. Walling emphasized on the necessity of revising and updating the syllabus and to discuss in faculty meetings. There are always rooms for change if it is beneficial and good for the students.

Towards the end of the meeting, Dr. Aokumla Walling made some important feedbacks and personal suggestions which are listed below -

- 1. History as a practical subject should be treated beyond the syllabus and for that Seminars and workshops should be conducted from time to time.
- 2. To set up a Research Committee or a small Research Wing emphasizing on culture. A small team of teachers can take the in-charge for a period of time which can help the students and also the teachers in research and teaching.
- 3. The department's museum should reach a good standard for which the Nagaland University can also lend its help.
- 4. Giving of notes to students should be discouraged and they should be trained how to work by themselves and to develop the culture of reading and research. Giving of notes to students limits the students learning and have an adverse effect on them as they go for higher studies.
- 5. Importance of clearing NET and registering for Ph.D was stressed for the faculty members.

The meeting concluded with Mr. Reimaya Muinao giving the Vote of Thanks.

The Board of Studies (BoS) meeting for the Department of Mathematics was held on 20th September 2019 at the Department of Mathematics, St. Joseph's College (autonomous) Jakhama.

The minutes of the meeting are listed as under:

- 1. The meeting started at 10:00 am.
- 2. Invocation and welcome address was said by Miss Imlienla, HoD Mathematics.
- 3. Meeting started with discussion on the already proposed SJC(A) B. Sc Mathematics syllabus where some changes were noted and was advised by Mr. R. K Paul, NU nominated member to implement the changes if possible from next new academic session. The detailed discussion and proposition made are mentioned below:
 - (i) Mr. R.K Paul noticed that there were 6 practical papers, so he suggested whether some practical papers can be replaced by tutorial classes, which carries 2 credits. He was concerned that the students should focus more on theoretical concepts rather than practical application at this stage.
 - (ii) He also suggested that the present paper MAT 102 -Calculus should be renamed as Linear Algebra where the full course of basic algebra can be studied in detail to help students prepare for further higher studies in abstract algebra.
 - (iii) Course title of the Generic Elective paper to be used as MAT GE 1,2,3 &4 instead of the proposed MAT 104, MAT 204, MAT 304, MAT 404.
 - (iv) Arrangements were done in the proposed syllabus so as to maintain a consistent study of the subject for the students.
 - (v) Finally he also advised that if the authority is willing, then allow the new batch of students 2020-23 to study the new syllabus proposed in the BoS meeting, dated 20th September 2019 for better learning experience. In case if it's not possible then wait for 3 years and reframe the syllabus as proposed in this meeting.
- 4. The meeting concluded with vote of thanks from Mr. C. Vinoth Kumar, Asst. Professor Mathematics.

5. The meeting got over at 12: 45 pm.





Minutes of the Board of Studies meeting, 20th September, 2019.

The meeting for the Board of Studies was called on 20th September 2019, wherein Dr. Y. Sundarayya, Assistant Professor, Nagaland University, Physics Department was invited for the deliberation and approval of the new CBCS syllabus at Dean of science office. The meeting was chaired by Ms.Thejano Theresa, Assistant Professor, HOD of Physics Department.

The meeting began with an invocation by Sr. Susai Mary, Dean of Science followed by welcome address by Ms. Thejano Theresa.

Deliberation of the new CBCS syllabus.

- Discussion of CBCS syllabus began with Dr. Y. Sundarayya advising on the restructuring of syllabus, if any to be made after 3 years as given by the UGC guidelines.
- Certain changes in the unit distribution and number of lectures allotment were discussed which were to be changed in the next revision. (each unit should have the same number of lectures)
- 3) In order to bring uniformity with the UGC guidelines, the nomenclature of the papers need to be reviewed along with the management (after 3 years).
- 4) On deliberation of generic electives, it was advised that some units/ topics can be similar with the core courses but its entirety is not recommended.
- 5) Credits given within the guidelines of UGC should not be exceeded.

MINUTES OF THE 2"dMEETINGWITH THE BOARD OF STUDIES

The review meeting of the Board of studies was convened at the Conference Hall, along with the faculties of the Department and the subject experts (University Nominee) Dr. Athungo Ovung, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology, Nagaland University Lumami Campus and Dr. Visakhono Hibo. Principal Japfu Christian College, Kigwema, Kohima on the 11th of July 2019 for the Syllabus on Choice Based Credit System(CBCS) both for Under Graduate Studies and Post Graduate Studies, where the drafted syllabus was presented to them along with the structure of the syllabus prepared by the faculties for modification and finalizing the syllabus.

The details of the discussion are as follows:-

- Dr. Medonuo Pienyu, Head of the department chaired the meeting and opened the discussion by highlighting the syllabus and the credits for papers under the CBCS System.
- 2. For the UG courses, as per the directives of the UGC approved syllabus, the department will have 14 core papers which will carry 6 credits thus for six semesters there will be a total of 84 credits (14x6= 84). There will be four Discipline Specific Elective (DSE)Course each carrying 6 credits (4x6=24), four Generic Elective (GE) (4x6=24), two Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) carrying 2 credits (2x2=4) and two Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) carrying two credits each (2x2=4). All together there will be 140 credits for the entire semester.
- 3. Dr. Medonuo stressed on the uniformity of units for each paper, thus it was decided that the syllabus shall contain 5 units for each courses and sub-topics (varies depending on the need of the topic). Each unit will carry 20 Marks. Thus, 20×5=100 marks for each course both for the UG and PG.
- 4. For the Skill Enhancement Course for the UG being a practical paper, the house decided not to keep a fixed units but opted to keep it open (subjected to modifications).
- 5. Dr. Athungo Ovung has also reminded that, while typing the syllabus we should ensure uniformity in the numbers and fonts used for the entire syllabus. The course content should be precise and objective of the course should be clear.
- 6. Along with the changes made on the course contents, units, chapterization and on the essential readings, an entirely new paper titled as "Social Movement" as a core course for UG was introduced by Mr. Lumchio Patton replacing the UGC paper "Introduction of Sociology" as C03 for the 2nd semester. After further discussions the house agreed to

replace the paper as it was felt that there is overlapping with topics taken in the other semester as well.

7. The House also discussed on the course, content, objectives to be taken at the post Graduate level. The details of the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for PG courses are given below.

Core Course: 14 courses (compulsory)

Elective Course: 6 courses

Choice Based Credit Transfer: 4 courses

Credit to be completed for award of degree: 76 credits

Minimum duration: 4 semesters (Two years)

Maximum duration: 6 semesters (Three years).

- 8. Semesters I and II will have 4 core courses of 4 credit each (4×4=16 credits per semester) and one CBCT course (to opt from another department) of 3 Credit each (1×3=3 credits per semester).
- 9. Semester III and IV will have 3 core courses of 4 credit each (3×4=12 credits per semester), 3 Elective papers of 4 credits (3×4=12 credits per semester) and CBCT courses for 3 credits each (1×3=3 credits per semester). Altogether 76 credits.
- 10. The revised syllabus for the PG was finalized and further discussion for upgrading the courses will be discussed in the next meeting.
- 11. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the HOD and the house deliberated on the need to meet at least once or twice in a year to upgrade the syllabus. The revised and final syllabus that was approved by the members of the board of studies is attached separately both for the UG and PG courses for the academic year 2019.

On asked about the weightage of 4 credits, Dr. Ramita clarified that 4 credits is equivalent to 100 marks, i.e., 1 credit carries 25 marks and that internal were conducted for 30 marks and external exams were conducted for 70 marks. It was then suggested by the subject expert that every unit should have credit and that credits must be shown instead of number of classes.
- 5. Discussions were held on how to divide the 5 units into 4 credits.
- 6. Miss. Rukutalu mentioned that it will be difficult to set the question papers if 0.5 credits was given for each unit, so the house decided to put 0.8 for each unit, i.e., 20 marks for one unit each.
- 7. Dr. Ramita mentioned about the 20% changes made in the syllabus, which was discussed in the meeting and was approved by the house.
- 8. Dr. Ramita also mentioned about field visit in Core Course II (CC II) and how to carry on since the credit given in the syllabus was only 2 credits.

a. Set up and maintain animal house.

b. Data Collection

c. Presentation/ Power Point Presentation

d. Sewage Treatment

e. Origami Prism

12. Some changes were made in the syllabus for theory paper CCIX and practical paper CCV
