## PROVISIONAL RESULT NOTIFICATION

(Undergraduate & Postgraduate Programme)

The Provisional Result of the *End Semester Examinations* held from November – December, 2024 is hereby declared. The published Provisional Result and the Provisional Statement of Marks can be accessed from the College website.

Any rectification(s) in the Provisional Result must be directed to the Office of the Controller of Examinations (by the student in person) from 13<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2025. No phone calls or messaging/ any social media platform shall be entertained.

#### **RE-EVALUATION**

- 1. Re-evaluation facility is available to the candidates subjected to the relevant rules and regulations:
  - i) A candidate securing **not less than 29% (20/70 or 10/35)** and **not more than 60% (42/70 or 21/35)** in the End Semester Examinations.
  - ii) Re-evaluation is allowed for a maximum of 2 theory papers only.
  - iii) There shall be no re-evaluation of the Practical Courses.
  - iv) The fee for re-evaluation is ₹1000/- per paper.
- 2. Application form may be collected from the College Office (Arts Block) from 13<sup>th</sup> 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2025.
- 3. The last date for submission of Application form is 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2025.
- 4. The results shall be declared to the applicants within 15 days from the closing date of reevaluation.

## **COMPARTMENTAL EXAMINATIONS OF THE NON-NEP 2020 BATCH**

In view of the implementation of the NEP 2020, Compartmental Examinations shall be made available the non-NEP 2020 batch for the following categories of students:

- 1. The fifth semester students who had missed their backlog(s) examinations or failed to clear the backlog(s) in the recently held examinations (November December, 2024).
- 2. The fifth semester regular students who had missed the examinations or failed the course in the recently held examinations (November December, 2024). The fifth semester regular students who had missed the examinations or failed the course are however permitted to write only 50% (two papers) of the total course. Hence, the students can opt for any two papers as Compartmental Examinations.

# **Important information for Compartmental Examinations**

- 1. Filling up of Compartmental Examinations form is 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2025.
- 2. The routine of the Compartmental Examinations shall be published on **15**<sup>th</sup> **January**, **2025**. However, please note that the Compartmental Examinations shall be held from **16**<sup>th</sup>  **20**<sup>th</sup> **January**, **2025**.
- 3. **Rs. 800/-** shall be charged for each paper as examination fee.

## **ISSUE OF MARKSHEET**

- 1. The date for issue of the Original Marksheet shall be notified after the commencement of the new Academic Sessin (Spring, 2025).
- 2. The Original Marksheet shall be issued to the concerned candidates only, or unless with proper authorization and verification duly approved by the Principal.
